

**The Environmental Impact Assessment (Land Drainage Improvement Works)  
Regulations 1999 (as amended)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **TRENT VALLEY INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD** proposes to carry out improvement works on the following watercourses in the Board's statutory district during 2020/21.

Works will involve the re-forming parts of the watercourse, the installation of access culverts and clearing trees and shrubs to enable maintenance access. All works will be carried out on one bank only which will be selected as necessary to minimise the environmental impact, following a technical and environmental survey.

The Board has undertaken an environmental appraisal and considers that the proposals are not likely to have a significant effect on the environment and does not, therefore, intend to prepare an Environmental Statement in respect of the works.
